The museum, set in an 18th century restored thatched cottage, displays a variety of interesting artefacts appealing to all ages such as antique china, toys and costumes, and Jacobite memorabilia and weapons - some of which were found locally after the battle of Culloden.

The family friendly, multi award-winning visitor centre offers exciting interactive displays and activities for adults and children alike. Discover the feeling of climbing on ice, explore the landscapes, wildlife and history then relax in the café before leaving with any additional information required from the information point on-site, including weather forecast and advice on walking and climbing routes in the area.
